VEHICLES ON ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROPERTY

A. PURPOSE

To establish a clear policy for the operation of vehicles on Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) property and to identify what vehicles, including aircraft, watercraft, and mobile vehicles are prohibited from AACPS property.

B. ISSUE

The Board of Education of Anne Arundel County (Board) recognizes the importance of a safe environment for AACPS students and staff. The Board is committed to maintaining a safe environment on AACPS property.

C. POSITION

- In accordance with State law, a person may not operate, park, or store a vehicle on AACPS property unless the person has in the person's possession written permission by AACPS. A person who is employed by AACPS or is an authorized school visitor, in accordance with Policy KD – Visitors to the Schools, may operate and park a vehicle on school property.
- 2. Unless granted written permission by AACPS as identified in subsection 1. above, vehicles that pose a reasonable risk of injury are prohibited from AACPS property at all times, including:
 - a. Vehicles with limited visibility to the vehicles' interior;
 - b. Inoperable vehicles;
 - c. Abandoned vehicles;
 - d. Off-road vehicles;

- e. Mobile vehicles, including equipment, grills, food trucks, storage trailers, and boat trailers;
- f. Recreational vehicles;
- g. Aircraft;
- h. Watercraft; and
- i. Vehicles identified to AACPS by law enforcement officials, as being stolen or as posing a reasonable risk of injury or threat to the public.
- 3. Vehicles shall be operated in a safe manner in accordance with State and local laws.
- 4. Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary actions and law enforcement action. Law enforcement action may include the removal of the vehicle at the expense of the registered owner of the vehicle.

D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
