### **Countywide Alt-MSA Performance**

Each year, some students are unable to take the regular paper-and-pencil version of the MSA. Consequently, these students take the Alternate Maryland School Assessment (Alt-MSA). This assessment consists of a portfolio of student work reflecting the same reading and mathematics objectives assessed on the paper-and-pencil version of the MSA. Table VII below illustrates the results and the change in pass rates compared to the 2012-13 assessment.
