There was a 13.5% increase from the 2013-2014 school year in the amount of scholarship money offered to Anne Arundel County Public Schools students countywide. This year, minority students were offered \$47,079,901 in scholarships. Of that amount, \$22.9 million in scholarships were offered to African-American students. There were three Gates Millennium Scholarships awarded to minority students who demonstrated strong academic achievement, as well as leadership and perseverance.
