BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

A. PURPOSE

To enable the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County (Board) to review its actions of the past year in relationship to the philosophy of the Board, short-range planning, long-range planning, Board strategy, mission, and appropriate Board policies.

B. ISSUE

A self-evaluation is an assessment instrument to determine strengths and gaps so as to identify areas of focus to support the Board's mission and school system's goals.

C. POSITION

1. The Board is committed to supporting student achievement through goal setting, continuous improvement, accountability, and collaborative leadership.
2. In conjunction with its annual retreat, the Board shall conduct a self-evaluation and discuss strategies to improve its effectiveness and monitor its progress.
3. The specific self-evaluation instrument, including criteria, subjects of evaluation, and process shall be reviewed annually and determined by the full Board prior to its annual retreat.
4. The evaluation content and method shall reflect the Board's agreed upon goals, priorities and governance responsibilities, and continuous commitment to educational equity.
