# STUDENT ATTIRE AND PERSONAL APPEARANCE

#### A. PURPOSE

To establish expectations for students regarding their attire and personal appearance.

#### B. ISSUE

Students have the responsibility to wear attire and to arrange their personal appearance in a manner which is healthy, safe, and does not pose a disruption to the educational process. Some schools have established school uniform requirements following the provisions of Policy JCDA and Regulation JCDA-RA – School Uniforms.

## C. POSITION

Students shall dress in clothes that promote a safe and respectful learning environment. Clothes that create a disruptive environment or cause a health or safety hazard are not appropriate and not acceptable at school.

## D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
