### SCHOOL SAFETY PATROLS

#### A. PURPOSE

To provide expectations regarding School Safety Patrols at schools.

#### **B. ISSUE**

School Safety Patrols facilitate movement of student pedestrian traffic through the use of student leaders to assist fellow students as they travel on school grounds.

#### C. POSITION

- School Safety Patrols, where established by a school, are a valuable asset to the mission of the Crossing Guard Program. School Safety Patrols wear familiar, high-visibility equipment and assist student pedestrian transit around the school. While they are expressly prohibited from directing traffic in any manner their visible presence, while escorting students, is a readily recognized alert for motorists to drive carefully on school parking lots and properties, as school children are in the area.
- 2. The principal at each school shall determine whether a School Safety Patrol is appropriate for his/her school.
- 3. When a principal determines need for a School Safety Patrol, the patrol will be established using regulations developed by the American Automobile Association.

#### D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
