- I. Students enrolled in kindergarten through twelfth grade may participate in curriculum offerings in any county public school provided that the course is not available at their assigned school, that there is space available in the course, and that the students provide their own transportation. Permission to exercise this option must be obtained from the principals or designees of the affected schools and the parents or legal guardians. Parental approval for courses outside of the home school is not required for students 18 years of age or older.
