SECONDARY COURSE ENROLLMENT OUTSIDE THE ASSIGNED SCHOOL

A. PURPOSE

To establish regulations regarding students taking courses outside the assigned school.

B. BACKGROUND

Due to a lack of demand at particular schools for a specific course of study, as well as limited fiscal resources, Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) recognizes it will not be able to offer the same course selections for all schools.

C. PROCEDURES

- 1. Eligible students enrolled in grades six through twelve may participate in curriculum offerings in any county high school, institution of higher education, and/or AACPS-approved on-line offerings if:
 - a. the course is not available in the assigned school;
 - b. there is space available in the course;
 - c. the days and times for the course schedule coincide with the student's schedule;
 - d. permission is received from the parent or legal guardian; and
 - e. the student or parents provide transportation to and from the school in which the course will be taken.
- 2. The principals or designees of the affected schools shall provide permission to exercise the option.
