SCHOOL VEHICLE DRIVER QUALIFICATIONS

A. PURPOSE

To establish procedures that school vehicle drivers must follow and complete prior to transporting Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) students.

B. BACKGROUND

School vehicle drivers must meet all certification processes of the Federal Motor Carriers Safety Administration (FMCSA), the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE), and the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA), as codified in federal and State laws and regulations.

C. PROCEDURES

1. Prospective school vehicle drivers must meet all applicable driver's license requirements established by the MVA or commercial driver's license requirements established by FMCSA prior to transporting AACPS students.
2. Prospective school vehicle drivers must meet all applicable regulations established by MSDE in the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) prior to transporting AACPS students.
3. Prospective school vehicle drivers must meet all applicable regulations established by MVA in COMAR prior to transporting AACPS students.
