HEALTHY SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

A. PURPOSE

To ensure Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) provides and maintains safe and healthy work and learning environments in accordance with known, applicable standards, laws, regulations, and guidelines. AACPS strives to eliminate or control foreseeable hazards, which may result in personal injuries or illnesses or damage to property or the environment.

B. ISSUE

A safe and healthy environment contributes to a favorable learning environment for students, productivity increases for teachers and staff, and a sense of comfort, health, and well-being for all staff and students. A well-designed, maintained, and operated facility can truly enhance performance and make education a more enjoyable and rewarding experience. These attributes combine to assist a school in its core mission of educating children.

Undesirable, unplanned accidents which can be prevented often result in bodily harm, loss of time, property damage, legal action, and even death.

Schools are often the central denominator of a community. Schools are used as social meeting places for recreation, religious services, and as shelters during weather and civil emergencies. A structurally sound and secure building that provides clean air, water, and shelter must be well maintained.

C. POSITION

1. The Board of Education of Anne Arundel County (Board) is committed to environmental health and safety as one of our top priorities. This effort is supported and reinforced through good management practices in combination with active employee and student participation.

2. The Board supports the establishment of appropriate environmental and safety program standards and procedures, training of our personnel on their duties and responsibilities, and monitoring the implementation and compliance objectives.
3. The Board directs the Superintendent to implement a comprehensive school safety plan regarding crisis intervention, emergency response, and management.
4. The Board directs the Superintendent to implement proactive environmental and safety programs, control unnecessary cost expenditures, reduce risk exposures, respond to the concerns of our occupants, and provide environmentally safe facilities for all.
5. Schools and offices shall be constructed and maintained to provide students, staff, and the community at large safe and environmentally healthy learning, working, recreational, and, when necessary, emergency environments.
6. The Board recognizes the federal, State, and local safety and environmental laws, regulations, and codes to be appropriate and consistent with this policy and shall comply with those requirements.
7. The Superintendent shall direct staff to establish and implement safety and environmental health programs that will meet or exceed applicable federal, State, and local laws, regulations, codes, and other recognized professional guidelines.
8. The Superintendent shall address adequate safety and health resource allocations to ensure deficiencies are corrected in a timely manner.
9. Employees of AACPS shall conduct all operations as safely as possible and take every reasonable precaution for the safety of students, employees, and visitors on school property.
10. The Superintendent shall establish and practice a comprehensive school safety plan regarding crisis intervention, emergency response, and management.

D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
