HEALTHY SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

A. PURPOSE

To establish procedures for development, implementation, and review of the policy on Healthy School Environment.

B. PROCEDURES

1. Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) adopts by reference the applicable federal, State, and local regulations and codes pertaining to employee safety, health, and the environment as listed below:
 - a. The Clean Air Act;
 - b. The Clean Water Act;
 - c. Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act;
 - d. The Emergency Planning & Community Right-to-Know Act;
 - e. The Endangered Species Act;
 - f. Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act;
 - g. The Occupational Safety and Health Act;
 - h. The Oil Pollution Act of 1990;
 - i. The Pollution Prevention Act;
 - j. The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act;
 - k. The Safe Drinking Water Act;

- l. The Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act;
 - m. The Toxic Substances Control Act;
 - n. Code of Maryland Regulations;
 - o. Anne Arundel County Codes and Regulations;
 - p. National Fire Protection Association;
 - q. Americans with Disabilities Act;
 - r. Homeland Security Act; and
 - s. Anne Arundel County Public School Comprehensive School Safety Plan.
2. AACPS adopts by reference the policy regarding School Safety Plans, School Safety Teams, and School Crisis Response.
 3. School emergency response plans specific to each school building shall be established and practiced by the school's principal.
