STUDENT TELEHEALTH

A. PURPOSE

To provide guidance to schools regarding student access to telehealth appointments during the school day within secondary school settings in Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS).

B. ISSUE

The Board of Education of Anne Arundel County (Board) believes that integrating telehealth services within the school community fosters a healthy environment that supports educational and emotional well-being for both parents/guardians and students. By leveraging technology to provide access to behavioral health services directly within the school environment, telehealth can bridge the gap between healthcare providers and students and families, ensuring timely and efficient care.

C. POSITION

School/practitioner-initiated telehealth services may be provided in AACPS in accordance with State law.

D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
