EXECUTIVE STAFF

A. PURPOSE

To provide the Superintendent with a team of experts in their respective fields that offer background information, advice, and recommendations regarding the various demands of running the school system and implementing the strategic goals of Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS), and to ensure the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County (Board) is informed regarding the promotions and appointments of Executive Staff employees in Unit VI.

B. ISSUE

Running a school system is complex and information and guidance from various departments and divisions are needed in order to assist the Superintendent with daily operations of the school system and strategic planning. The Superintendent needs a team of highly skilled individuals who provide diverse expertise in their respective fields to assist with planning, advising, and running the school system. Additionally, in accordance with State law, on the written recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board shall appoint all personnel.

C. POSITION

1. The Superintendent shall recommend Unit VI Executive Staff employees for appointment by the Board. The exhibit items which accompany the Board agenda and are distributed to Board members prior to each meeting shall include the names, current resume, and anticipated salary of all individuals who are recommended for positions in Unit VI.
2. Such positions shall be reflected in the administrative organizational chart in accordance with Policy CC – Organizational Chart.

D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
