PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR SELECTION OF SCHOOL SITES

A. PURPOSE

To affirm compliance with the Education Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

B. ISSUE

If the Board gives preliminary approval of a school site, the Board shall hold a public hearing if:

- 1. the Board considers it desirable;
- 2. 100 or more adult residents of the county petition in writing for a hearing; or
- 3. the county council asks for a hearing.

C. POSITION

The Education Article provides that:

- 1. The hearing shall be held no sooner than ten days after a notice has been published in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the county, advising interested persons of the opportunity to present their views.
- 2. Any petition by residents of the county shall be filed at the office of the Board within 15 days after the Board gives preliminary approval of the site;
- 3. If a hearing is held, minutes shall be kept and, after deliberation, the Board shall send the minutes of the hearing and its recommendation to the State Superintendent for use in making a decision on approval of the site.
- 4. A request for site approval may not be made by the Board to the State Superintendent until after 15 days following action on recommending the site; or, if a hearing is held, until after the hearing, whichever occurs last.
