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- I. *Policy: 706*
- II. *Procedure: The Board will consider the recommendation of committees of parents concerning the naming of schools after the following conditions have been met:*
- A. *The principal has been appointed;*
 - B. *The Department of Planning and Construction has determined the attendance area of school;*
 - C. *The principal has fully publicized through the press, handbills, etc., the date and time of a parent meeting called for the purpose of selecting the name of the school;*
 - D. *Names for the school will be solicited by letters to parents and from parents at the meeting. The collection of names will be presented to those in attendance, who will make a selection by ballot. It is suggested that the process of elimination be used, dropping approximately 25 percent of the names each time the vote is taken; and*
 - E. *The principal or his designee, acting as secretary, will notify the Board of the outcome of the meeting.*
