BOARD POWERS AND DUTIES

A. PURPOSE

To establish the powers and duties of the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County (Board).

B. ISSUE

In accordance with State law, the Board shall be empowered to perform specified duties to provide for the education of the students of Anne Arundel County.

C. POSITION

The Board members shall:

1. Carry out the Board's responsibilities in accordance with State law as well as the bylaws, rules, regulations, and policies of the Maryland State Board of Education;
2. Maintain a reasonably uniform system of public schools throughout Anne Arundel County to provide a quality education and equal educational opportunity for all children of Anne Arundel County;
3. Establish, with the advice of the Superintendent of Schools, the educational policies of Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS); and
4. Adopt, codify, and make available to the public policies and regulations regarding the conduct and management of AACPS, in accordance with State law.
