## HOMELESS STUDENTS

### A. PURPOSE

To ensure the Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) fully implements the provisions of the *McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Improvements Act* of 2001 and subsequent amendments (*McKinney-Vento*) concerning the education of homeless children and unaccompanied youth.

### B. ISSUE

*McKinney-Vento* requires schools to ensure homeless children and unaccompanied youth, including preschool-aged children, have equal access to educational programs. To achieve compliance with *McKinney-Vento*, AACPS shall establish procedures that govern the identification, school registration, enrollment, coordination of services, transfer, and withdrawal of homeless students and unaccompanied youth.

### C. POSITION

AACPS will work with homeless students and their families, as well as unaccompanied youth, to ensure full compliance with *McKinney-Vento* in order to promote enrollment, retention, and success in school.

### **D. IMPLEMENTATION**

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement this policy.
