

## AACPS Graduation Rate for Four Year Cohort

Anne Arundel County Public Schools

March 2019



The adjusted cohort graduation rates are based on a prescribed method of tracking a given cohort of students to determine how many of them graduated within 4-years of starting high school.<sup>1</sup> New student groups for reporting with the Class of 2018 include homeless, foster care, and military connected students.

The following two tables show the graduation rate for four-year cohorts<sup>2</sup> since Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rates began with the 9<sup>th</sup>-grade cohort in 2006-2007 and over the last two graduating cohorts, Class of 2017 and Class of 2018.

<sup>2</sup> The four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate is the number of students who graduate in four years with a regular high school diploma divided by the number of students who form the adjusted cohort for the graduating class. For any given cohort, students who are entering grade 9 for the first time form a cohort that is subsequently “adjusted” by adding any students who transfer into the cohort later during the next three years and subtracting any students who transfer out, immigrates to another country, or dies during that same period.
